Selected participants will attend the 2025 ASRT Educational Symposium and Annual Governance and House of Delegates Meeting in Albuquerque, NM on June 24-29, 2026.

Participants Receive

- Airfare, housing, a stipend for meals and other travel expenses.
- An educational program designed just for students.
- A professional mentor assigned for the meeting.
- An insider's look into the largest association for medical imaging and radiation therapy professionals.
- An opportunity to work closely with OSRT board members.

Eligibility

- Must be a student member of the ASRT and OSRT at time of submission.

How to Apply

 Applications are required to follow application requirements for both the OSRT and ASRT.

- **Submit** a video less than 4 minutes in length answering the following questions:
 - 1. Introduction: Introduce yourself with your name, school, graduation date, and why you chose the profession.
 - 2. Describe a time you demonstrated leadership or initiative in your academic or clinical experiences. What was the outcome, and what did you learn from it?
 - 3. How do you plan to use the opportunities and connections from the ASRT Student to Leadership Development Program to benefit your school, your future workplace, or the radiologic sciences community?
 - 4. How do you plan to stay involved with the OSRT?
- **Submit** a recommendation letter from your program director, which includes a statement that you have their approval to attend the 2026 ASRT Educational Symposium and Annual Governance and House of Delegates Meeting, June 24-29, 2026 in Albuquerque, NM.

Applications close on **October 31st, 2025** and participants will be notified no later than December 20th, 2025. Information and correspondence from ASRT will begin in January 2024. At least one student OSRT member will be selected to participate.

If chosen as one of the OSRT student representatives to the ASRT Student to Leadership Development Program the recipient will be asked to do one of the following:

 Write a brief article for the OSRT website/newsletter about their experience as a participant in the Student to Leadership Development Program. Attend the 2026 OSRT Annual Conference in Lincoln City and volunteer for 4 hours at the annual conference

OR

 Attend two meetings, one OSRT Board meeting prior to and one Student Action Committee meeting after attending the ASRT Student to Leadership Development Program.

In addition, students will be asked to share about their experiences at future board meetings as a way to give back to incoming students.

Applicant Certification

I hereby authorize the release of all information contained in this application packet as may be required to determine my eligibility for selection as a participant. I hereby waive my rights to review any documents pertaining to my application once submitted.

 I understand that if I choose to cancel or am unable to attend the Student to Leadership Development Program that I will be expected to reimburse the ASRT for all travel costs incurred. I have read and accept the Student to Leadership Development terms and conditions. 		

Application acceptance ends October 31st 2025 at 11:59pm Pacific Standard Time. All entries must be received by the OSRT prior to the end date and time. This contest is only open to participants who submit original content that they have personally created or those who have been selected by their ASRT affiliate society. Submissions must be in English.

Each participant may submit only one entry. At least one applicant per affiliate shall be selected as winners and notified by December 20th 2025. It is the sole discretion of OSRT and ASRT to accept or reject any submission. OSRT and ASRT's decisions as to the administration, methodology of the 2026 ASRT Student to Leadership Development Program and the selection of the winners are final.

In exchange for acceptance as a participant in the 2026 ASRT Student to Leadership Development Program, each recipient agrees to assign to OSRT and ASRT, upon request, all copyright, trademark and other intellectual property rights in his/her winning essay to ASRT, 15000 Central Ave. SE, Albuquerque, NM 87123.

Entry participants release OSRT and ASRT and its directors, officers, partners, employees and agents from any and all liability with respect to participation in the 2026 ASRT Student to Leadership Development Program and participation in, and travel to or from, the 2026 ASRT Student to Leadership Development Program.

The 2026 ASRT Student to Leadership Development Program is open only to OSRT and ASRT student members, who are 18 years of age or older and enrolled as a student in an accredited medical imaging program at the time of submission.

Selection to participate in the 2026 ASRT Student to Leadership Development Program includes complimentary round trip airfare (must use Gant Travel) valued at up to \$1,000, a stay at a hotel selected by ASRT, meals provided as part of the program and a daily stipend at the current U.S. General Services Administration's per diem rates for Albuquerque. In the event that a winner lives in the Albuquerque area, or elects not to use the airfare component of the prize, the airfare component will be forfeited, and ASRT will provide no compensation or substitution for any difference in prize value.
